# Curtin Avenue Night Works

4 to 8 March 2019 – Cottesloe

### Nightworks

We wish to advise road users, residents and businesses that we will be working at night on Curtin Avenue, as part of the Cottesloe Principal Shared Path (PSP) project.

From **Monday 4 March to Friday 8 March 2019**, we will be working on Curtin Avenue at the Gibney Street intersection. We anticipate that the works will be completed over two shifts on Monday and Tuesday nights. However, three additional night shifts have been allocated to allow for operational and weather circumstances beyond our control.

Traffic management will be in place and road users should expect delays when moving through the work area.

Road users should be aware that traffic lanes will be closed in the vicinity of the work site while the works are in progress. However, Keslake will endeavour to maintain traffic flow through the area.

### Noise management and Works hours

Residents in the adjacent area may hear construction and machinery noise related to the works.

Every effort will be made to select machinery and work methods that minimise noise, where possible. We will also plan noisier tasks to occur earlier in the evening.

Our work hours will be **7pm to 7am each night**.
