

Great Eastern Highway Dual Carriageway

ANZAC DRIVE TO GATACRE DRIVE

Construction of a 2.4km four lane dual carriageway between Anzac Drive and Gatacre Drive, with dedicated turning lanes, intersection improvements and a footpath for pedestrians.

Issues

- The 2km section of Great Eastern Highway through the light industrial estate between Anzac Drive and Gatacre Drive is the only section within the City of Kalgoorlie- Boulder that is not a dual carriageway.
- The existing drainage system does not accommodate run-off during seasonal rain events
- Traffic congestion and accessibility difficulties for heavy vehicles accessing commercial properties fronting Great Eastern Highway

Benefits

- Improve overall capacity, safety and accessibility for road users with upgrades to lighting, drainage, road surface and intersection improvements
- Improve drainage, to accommodate run-off into an underground pipe and surface drainage system
- Reduce congestion with the construction of a dual carriageway able to accommodate higher volumes of traffic including heavy vehicles
- Improve amenity for cyclists and pedestrians
- Improve the aesthetics of the western entry to the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder

The \$14 million project is funded by the State's Royalties for Regions program and is expected to begin in late 2018.
