

Great Eastern Highway safety upgrade

BILGOMAN ROAD TO KINTORE ROAD

Stage 2 safety upgrade works for Great Eastern Highway, from Bilgoman Road to Kintore Road, to start in September.

Main Roads is about to start on Stage 2 of the *Great Eastern Highway safety upgrade: Bilgoman Road to Mann Street* in the Shire of Mundaring.

Stage 1, between Kintore Road and Mann Street, was completed in late 2017 and we are currently revegetating this section.


In September 2018, we will start widening and upgrading the 5.2 kilometre stretch of highway between Bilgoman Road and Kintore Road to include sealed shoulders, intersections with turning pockets and new shared paths connecting bus stops.

We will also be modifying the intersection of Great Eastern Highway with Park Road and Hardey Road to improve safety at this busy location. This includes restricting right turns from Park Road and Hardey Road to reduce the potential for conflict in the intersection.

This work should be finished in mid-2019 and will be complemented by new street lighting, road markings, signage and drainage, sealed bus bays, traffic barriers and improved driveway access.

Western Power and Telstra have started preparing for the road upgrade, by relocating some of their services and moving street lights.

This \$34 million project is jointly funded by the State and Federal Government, and supported by the Shire of Mundaring.



The intersection of Park and Hardey roads with Great Eastern Highway will be modified to improve safety.

Preserving the environment

There will be some clearing for Stage 2, however this will be minimised by maintaining the current level of the carriageways, installing safety barriers and locating street lights within the verge, where possible.

Any vegetation cleared will be mulched and re-used on site and replanting will be completed next winter, in consultation with the Shire of Mundaring.

Driveway improvements

As part of this project, all properties fronting Great Eastern Highway will be provided with new crossovers. The contractor will provide advance written notice of these works to ensure minimal inconvenience during construction.

Pre-construction surveys

If you own a property along the section of Great Eastern Highway within the designated construction zone, you will be offered a pre-construction building survey prior to the work. Main Roads encourages you to accept this offer, as it is your protection in the unlikely event of any damage as a result of the work.
