Speed and Parking Changes

March to September 2019 – Subiaco Road and White Place

Speed and parking changes

As part of the Hamilton Street Bridge Replacement project, additional traffic management changes are being implemented on Subiaco Road and White Place to enhance safety for cars, cyclists and pedestrians while the Hamilton Street Bridge works are underway.

Until **September 2019**, changes to **parking and speed limits on Subiaco Road and White Place** will be applied as follows:

- **Subiaco Road** (between White Place and Loftus Street) speed will be reduced to **40km/hr at all times**.
- **White Place** (west side) **street parking** will be banned to assist cyclists and pedestrians using the shared path detour.
- Subiaco Road (south side) between **Hamilton Street and Loftus Street only, street parking** will be banned to enhance visibility for all road users. ***Parking on Subiaco Road west of Hamilton Street remains unaffected.***

All road users are requested to show courtesy when moving through the area and obey all signs, signals and traffic controllers. Main Roads would like to thank road users for their patience during the bridge replacement project.

Friday 15 to Monday 18 March – 24/7 works and local road access

We will be removing the Hamilton Street Bridge structure from Friday 15 to Monday 18 March. This work will be undertaken during the night and day.

Residents in the adjacent area may hear construction and machinery noise related to the bridge removal, including concrete and wood sawing and cutting.

All rail services on the Fremantle line will also be closed from Friday 7.30pm to Monday first service.
