

# Kwinana Freeway Southbound On-ramp From Manning Road Project



**THE KWINANA FREEWAY SOUTHBOUND ON-RAMP FROM MANNING ROAD PROJECT IS FUNDED BY THE AUSTRALIAN AND STATE GOVERNMENTS AS PART OF A \$2.3 BILLION INVESTMENT IN ROAD AND RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE, ANNOUNCED IN MAY 2017.**

## Preliminary design

The Manning Road southbound on-ramp will provide road network connectivity for road users wishing to travel south on Kwinana Freeway from Manning Road.

The project will also resolve travel time inefficiencies and rat running through the local area, and will reduce congestion and improve safety at the Canning Bridge and Kwinana Freeway Interchange by redistributing traffic to a more direct route south from Manning Road.

## Local access changes

- Southbound on-ramp from Manning Road to Kwinana Freeway.

### Clydesdale Street

- No access changes, right-turn pocket installed.

### Lockhart Street south

- Cul-de-sac at Manning Road intersection.

### Edgecombe Street

- No change to access.

### Ley Street

- Minor intersection upgrade to enhance efficiency, all turning and through movements maintained.
