Manning Road Southbound On-ramp to Kwinana Freeway

From **6 to 16 February 2018** we will be undertaking work to locate underground services and identify ground conditions to inform early design works for the Manning Road Southbound On-ramp to Kwinana Freeway project.

These site investigation works will be undertaken from **7am to 5pm Monday to Friday** on the verge with the adjacent traffic lanes subject to reduced speeds.

Some on road works will also be required between **9am and 3pm Monday to Friday** to minimise effects on traffic and adjacent residents and to complete the works as quickly as possible.

When on-road works are required, traffic management will be in place on Manning Road in Como between Clydesdale Street and Lockhart Street. This will include a reduced speed limit and a single lane closure, at times. Investigations will also occur on Canning Parade up to Edgewater Street, however this will not impact traffic.

The emergency lane on Kwinana Freeway southbound will also be closed on one day as part of the works between the Manning Road overpass and the Edgewater Street Bridge.

In general, driveway access won't be affected during the lane closures. On **one day only**, the Mt Henry Tavern driveway access from Manning Road will be closed. **Access to Mt Henry Tavern will remain available from Edgcombe Street and Lockhart Street during this time.**

We would like to thank residents and road users in the area for their patience and understanding while this important project is being progressed.

These works form part of underground investigations that are essential for the project design to progress.

Noise management and works hours

Residences close to Manning Road may hear construction and machinery noise as the works are undertaken.

We ask road users to obey signs and signals and move through the area with caution.
