

Mitchell Freeway Southbound Widening

Cedric Street to Vincent Street

Fact Sheet – Afterhours Works Management

BMD Constructions, on behalf of Main Roads, is delivering the Mitchell Freeway Southbound Widening project, from Cedric Street and Vincent Street.

Upon completion in late 2019, there will be 7km of additional lane on Mitchell Freeway southbound to improve congestion through the area. Construction is scheduled to commence in November 2018.

Night works

Some night works will be necessary during construction, due to requirements for lane closures and the realignment of traffic on a fully functional freeway.

The high daytime traffic levels on the freeway prevent the closure of lanes during daytime hours.

The safety of road users and construction workers is also increased by doing some works at night.

We understand the works may cause disruption to residents in proximity to the freeway and have a number of measures in place to mitigate impacts.

Minimising disruption

To minimise disruptions, we will undertake the following actions:

- Where possible, we will prioritise works that are in proximity to residents for earlier in the evening and will attempt to finish these as early as possible.
- The location of night works will be rotated over the distance of the works to reduce the likelihood of the project disturbing the same area over consecutive nights.
- Where it is technically possible we will replace reversing beepers with low impact squawkers.
