

Mitchell Freeway Southbound Widening Cedric Street to Vincent Street

Fact Sheet - Principal Shared Path Detour

As part of the Mitchell Freeway Southbound Widening project, a series of Principal Shared Path (PSP) detours are required to allow for the construction of cycling underpasses.

The project includes a new PSP from Glendalough Station to Hutton Street, with two underpasses at Hutton Street and a bridge over Scarborough Beach Road.

Detours for cyclists and pedestrians

Several options have been carefully considered to maintain a north-south route for PSP users during construction, and ensure the safety of cyclists, pedestrians, road users and the construction workforce.

The safety of road crossings, lighting, service relocations, earthworks and bridge construction works are all considered when planning detours. Construction vehicles will be moving throughout the project area, creating numerous 'clash-points' between the new works and the existing PSP.

With safety our highest priority, detours onto local roads have been determined as the safest option to separate PSP users from construction activities.

The first detour will allow for the construction of a PSP underpass at the Hutton Street freeway exit ramp.

It will be in place from February until October 2019, and will extend from Telford Crescent to Hutton Street in Stirling. **See map overleaf.**

Signage

Temporary signs showing the detour route will be located at PSP entry points and will remain in place for the duration of the detours.

Directional signage will guide cyclists through the detour route. The effectiveness and condition of detour signage will be regularly monitored.

Resident and road user precautions

Road users are asked to take extra care when driving along the detour route:

- Look out for cyclists at all times
- Slow down when passing cyclists
- Take extra care when exiting and entering driveways
- On bin day, place your rubbish bins carefully to avoid obstructions on footpaths.

Cyclists and pedestrians may be required to use roads they are not familiar with.


