




Wanneroo Road Dual Carriageway - Joondalup Drive to Flynn Drive

3.5 KILOMETRE DUAL CARRIAGEWAY ON WANNEROO ROAD BETWEEN JOONDALUP DRIVE AND FLYNN DRIVE

ISSUES

- Traffic volumes on Wanneroo Road are expected to grow rapidly due to urban expansion and growth of the Neerabup Industrial Area.
- Wanneroo Road between Joondalup Drive and Flynn Drive is currently an isolated section of single carriageway, creating a pinch point. This results in northbound and southbound congestion impacting more than 26,000 vehicles per day.
- Congestion in this location results in traffic delays and an above average crash rate.

BENEFITS

-  Remove existing pinch point to alleviate current congestion
-  Support other significant road infrastructure projects in the area
-  Accommodate increasing volumes of traffic generated by population growth and industrial development in the North West corridor of the Perth Metropolitan area

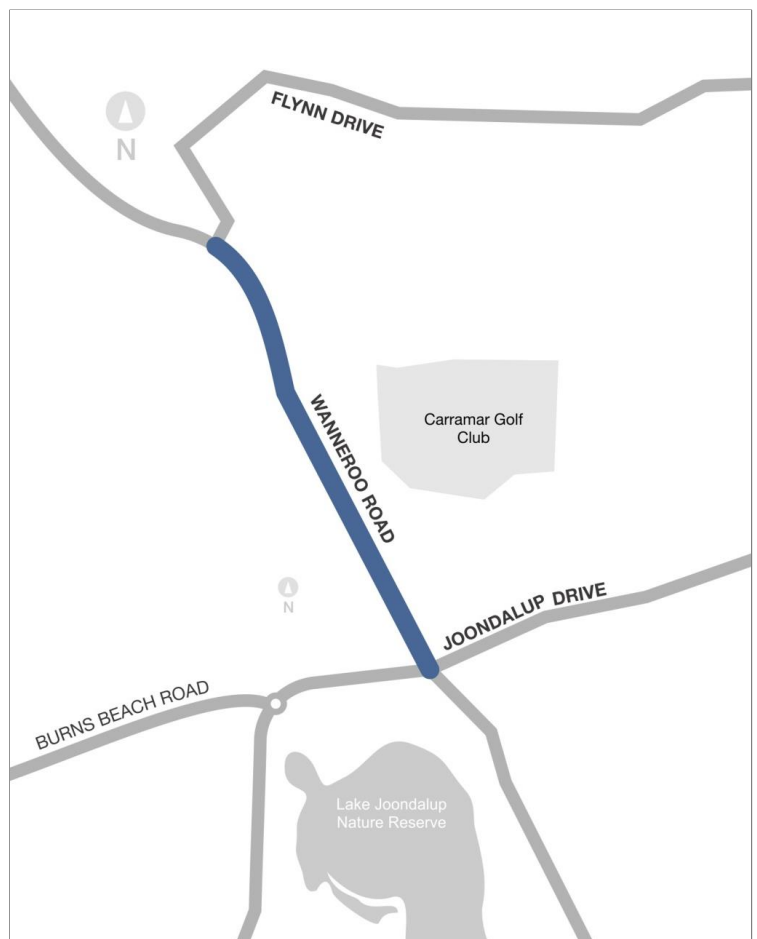
